

Energy efficiency to fit your business.

Incentives are available to support both the Feasibility Study, and the resulting energy efficient equipment and installation. Steps 1 and 2 of this checklist must be completed in order to receive incentives.

How to get started:

1

Feasibility Study

This required study will determine the viability of your project. There are two options:

a) Complete the study with funding from Efficiency Nova Scotia

- In partnership with your Consultant, fill out your Feasibility Study Incentive Application, and send to Efficiency Nova Scotia for approval.
- Once your application is approved, carry out the Feasibility Study.
- To receive your incentive, send in a completed study and copy of the invoice from your Consultant.

b) Complete the study without funding, or use an existing study

- Send in finished Feasibility Study for review. The study must meet the requirements outlined in the Feasibility Study Guide.
- Efficiency Nova Scotia will review and confirm approval of your study.

Implement Project

Once your Feasibility Study has been approved:

- You will be sent an incentive offer to accept within 30 days.
- Review, sign, and return the Project Development Agreement within 30 days. This is your contract with Efficiency Nova Scotia outlining the agreed upon incentive and terms and conditions.
- Implement the project as outlined.
- Once completed, work will be verified, and you will receive the approved incentive.

Identify opportunities at your facility with an optional Scoping Study.

- Complete a Scoping Study with a Consultant of your choice.
- Within three months of completion, send in a copy of your Scoping Study, rebate application, and invoices to Efficiency Nova Scotia to receive half the cost back (up to \$1,000).
